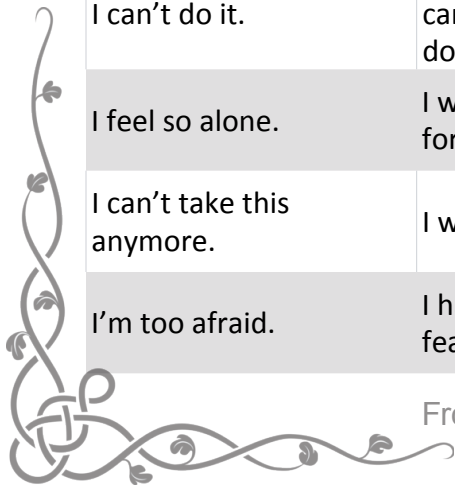
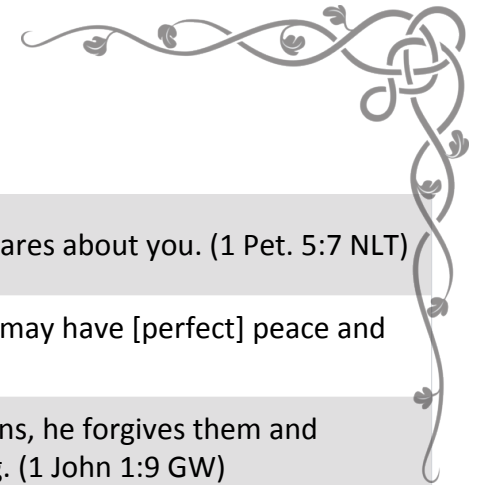
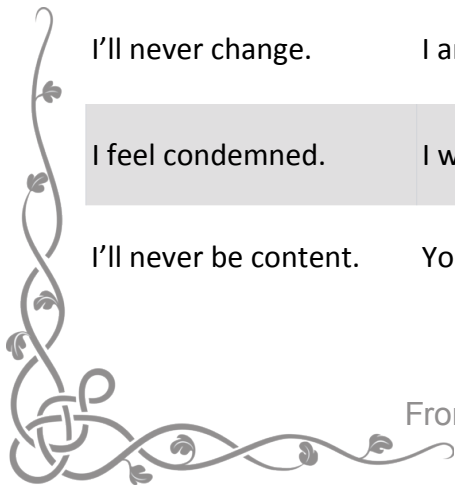


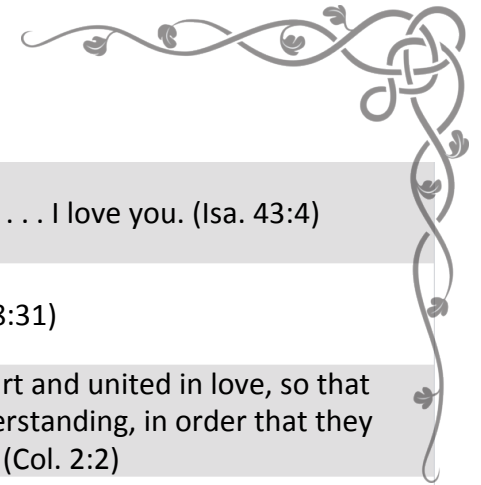
WHEN I SAY	GOD SAYS	POWERFUL PROMISES

I don't have enough confidence.	I will be your confidence.	For the LORD will be your confidence and will keep your foot from being caught. (Prov. 3:26 NASB)
I'm not strong enough.	I am your strength.	God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever. (Ps. 73:26)
I don't know what to do.	I will give you wisdom.	If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. (James 1:5)
I feel so depressed.	Let My love and faithfulness guard your heart.	Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is [His] faithfulness. (Lam. 3:21-23)
